### South Africa:

The arrival of these resources is so well timed for the upcoming South African mission. There is still a 'never ending' stream of ministries collecting materials. Many of the people are amazed that there is no cost involved for them. This is of course due the generosity of Love Packages.

We praise God for the safe return of our mission team. They conducted church services, seminars, lectures at Bible colleges, film evangelism, school meetings and outreaches throughout Zimbabwe, Zambia and Botswana. The team conducted 78 meetings, travelled a total distance of 8,600km, and passed through over 108 police stops and road blocks in Zimbabwe and Zambia alone! In Zimbabwe, the mission team confronted humanism and encouraged believers to take the ministry of discernment seriously. Ministry in Zambia dealt with corruption, Biblical preaching, holiness, and the Christian work ethic. In Botswana, they especially stressed the importance of evangelism and discipleship. After listening to a few messages, one woman responded, "I felt like the Scriptures were cutting my heart". She, along with many others, went out to evangelize in the nearby market place, after which their faces were shining and hearts were joyful because they told others about the way of salvation. The mission was completed without any of the team falling sick and without any vehicle breakdowns. Several tons of Bibles, New Testaments, Gospel booklets and Evangelistic and Discipleship tracts were delivered to churches, schools, colleges and Mission bases where they are most appreciated and studied, distributed and applied in the local communities. Our goal is still 2,200 tons for this year. So far we have been able to ship out 1405 tons, 800 tons more to go.

The availability of containers has been a big problem. In the month of August we were only able to ship 5 container loads, we should have done 15. The shipping crises around the world is something that I have never seen before. I asked all of you to pray on Facebook and over 9,000 of you said you would pray, now it looks like it is beginning to change. We have a lot of loads booked and material ready to go. Please continue to pray for us.

The price of everything is going up. I am sure you see it everyday too. Our costs for shipping containers is up, but we will continue to ship, because the harvest is before us, and we must not slacken the pace.

The testimonies that we receive tell us that the Church is growing and is alive. God is doing great things with the literature that we send. The harvest is here and Christ is worthy of His inheritance. He has bought and paid for them with His own blood!
